The European Federation of Geologists (EFG) and the French Geological Society (SGF) are pleased to announce a **second call for applications for travel grants** to support French-speaking students (Bachelor and Masters) wishing to participate in LearnGeo 2026.

These grants are generously **sponsored by Sunrise Education**, the official industry-university-research internship base of China University of Geosciences (Beijing).

Three participants will be selected. Each grant provides financial support of up to **€330 per person** to help cover travel and accommodation expenses. Participation in the LearnGeo event itself is free of charge.

How to apply

Applicants are invited to submit the following documents:

- Motivation letter (maximum one page, Word format) outlining their interest in participating in the event
- Curriculum Vitae
- Proof of student or student status (valid student ID or equivalent)
- Estimated travel and accommodation costs

Important information

- The event will be held in French. Applicants must therefore be able to actively participate in French.
- Selected grantees must provide proof of attendance during the event.
- The grant will be reimbursed after the event (up to €330) upon submission of supporting documents confirming the expenses incurred.
